

### **Artist Statement**

Suman Dey is a self-taught artist, who works in the language of abstract art. He had started his career painting pictures on mythological subjects, which he abandoned around 2014. Although inspired by the non-representational paintings of Prabhakar Kolte and Ganesh Haloi, he, instead of using the bright chromatic palette like them, explores the abstract shapes painted in dark, greyish monochrome, which adds solidity to the shapes. He follows a slow and contemplative method, distilling the visible forms – be it a butterfly or a handbag – into abstract motifs and colours. However, he does not simply exclude the references of the external world to attain the pure forms, cutting at the root of the idea of artistic imitation, rather wishes to create an entirely imaginative equivalent of the moods and memories provoked by the world. In other words, Suman Dey explores the state of mind without going beyond it.

His early semi-abstract painting represents the formative stage of his artistic process. Later, he disengages painting from the visible world, building compositions based on the traces that the world has left in the mind. His recent work is characterized by an intense preoccupation with large and bold shapes concerning the play of imagination and the subconscious mind. Mixing formal approaches with elements of surrealism, he creates an expressive, non-representational language to capture a wide range of thoughts, sentiments, and values. For the low-intensity colour scheme, his paintings' mood is rather sad. The dilapidated structures and stains on the abstract shapes in the paintings indicate our polluted and toxic environment, speaking of the apocalypse of our modern civilization in the age of global warming.





Suman Dey is a young contemporary artist based in Kolkata. Largely self-taught, he works in the language of abstract art, distilling the visible form to an abstract motif. His work, which usually tells no story, shows his intense contemplation and careful formal exercises. *Composition* and *Form* are two recent series of paintings that show his complex handling of the non-representation language of art oscillating between the purity of form and emotions and memories of the world.

Suman Dey has exhibited widely in India. He participated in the solo shows at Taj Bengal, Kolkata (2011, 2014); ECA Art Walk, Kolkata (2011) and Chemould Art Gallery, Kolkata (2008). His works have also been shown in many duet and group exhibitions in Academy of Fine Arts, Kolkata (2009, 2015, 2017); Shilpi Art Gallery (2008); in the Birla Annual Exhibition at Birla Academy of Art & Culture, Kolkata (2018, 2016); in the Annual Exhibition at Academy of Fine Arts, Kolkata (2017), in the All India Exhibition at Emami Art (2016, 2017) and in the Annual exhibition organized by the Rajya Charukala Parisad (2016); among others.

He was awarded the Certificate of Merit for his work in the All Indian Exhibition at Emami Art, 2017. Suman lives and works in Kolkata, India.
